REPORTS:

- -Code Enforcement Officer John Howland submitted his report for June. There were 5 permits issued for the month of June.
- -Oswego County Legislator Potter read his report, the County agenda can be found on the Oswego County Website.
- -Water Board No report
- Highway Superintendent Douglas Henry handed in the equipment repair cost report for June and went over the highway bills.
 - Superintendent Henry has negotiated with Stadium International to decrease the bill for the radiator repair. Stadium will not charge for the parts.
 - Extreme Winter Recovery money will be received from New York State.
